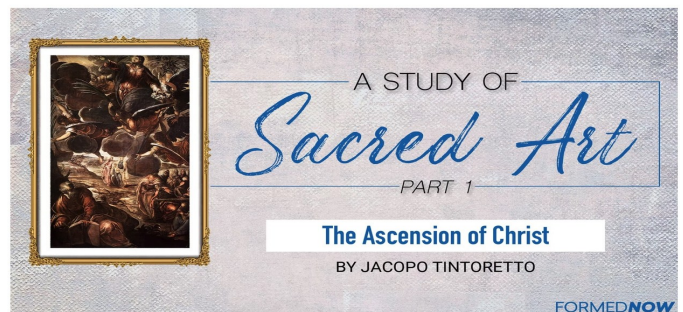
ANNOUNCEMENTS

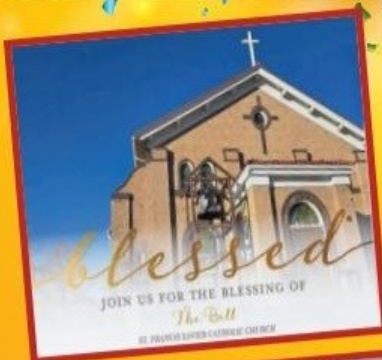
